First Ordinary Resolution

- (a) \$[16,000] per annum be paid to the President (1 person);
- (b) \$[8,000] per annum be paid to each Vice President (1 person); and
- (c) \$[4,000] per annum be paid to each other Director (5 persons),

For the period up until the next Annual General Meeting, and each such amount will be paid monthly in arrears, provided that if any Director serves in office for any period of less than a calendar month, then the payment for that month will be prorated on a daily basis.
